<u>PONDS</u>: J. Beaulieu reported that he will be meeting with the Beautification committee on July 16th to discuss plans for restoring areas around the pond impacted by the recent dredging project. He has agreed to provide money from his budget to replace fence panels in their original locations, and will repair the corner by building up rocks and dirt. Anything further is within the purview of the Beautification Committee. Anything planted should be indigenous to pond/wetland areas. In light of the upcoming meeting on the 16th, this item will be removed from the upcoming July 12 BOG agenda.

<u>CLUBHOUSE</u>: Louise reported ongoing problems with unauthorized parking at the Clubhouse, often for multiple days at a time. She has not purchased more signs, as people seem to be ignoring them, at least on the playground side of the house.
